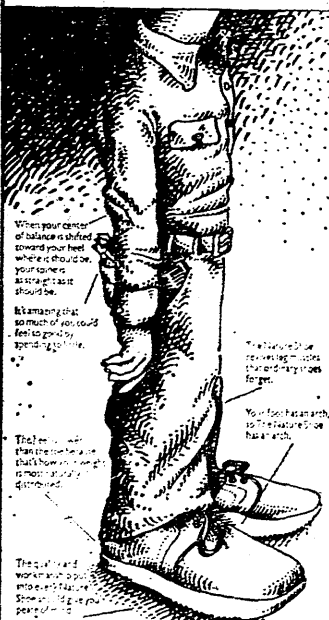
## Is college still worth it?
