

# Actress plays 3 twigs and a tree at Cabaret

At the conclusion of the comedy drama "Twigs" at You Are Cabaret Dinner Theater, Pa turns to Ma and remarks, "You know what I always say: As the tree is bent, so grows the twigs."

This comment sheds light on the reason for the title of the play and explains its theme.

The comedy is essentially a character study of the three female offspring of one mother. Each daughter is a meddlesome, irritating person in her own right, the reasons for which become glaringly obvious at the play's final scene.

At this time we meet the tree, the mother from which these women have sprung. And a withered, eccentric old lady she is.

Written by George Furth, "Twigs" is an actress's delight, for it features one woman playing four different female roles of various ages.

While Broadway had Sada Thompson in this part which won her a Tony Award, You Are Cabaret has Rhoda Rosen. Whatever else may be said of this comedy, the role of four babbling women of various ages is considerably demanding. Miss Rosen manages to continually alter her appearance and, even more amazingly, her voice and mannerisms to become four separate, convincing personalities.

The difficulty with "Twigs" lies in the inescapable fact that each of the four characters she portrays is a nagging, distraught person. In any event, they are all too similar in personality quirks to warrant four separate vignettes.

Scene one centers around a lonely widow who, in the process of moving into a new apartment, meets a

lonely man.

The reunion of two brutish army buddies provides the setting for scene two. Their attempts to reminisce and discuss sports are constantly impeded by an irksome wife who is about to suffer her third nervous breakdown.

In the third vignette, a couple's bickering over the dinner table is disturbed by the unannounced presence of a relative who brings with him an anniversary present. The gift greatly distresses the superstitious woman who believes that the celebration of an anniversary will result in the death of either the husband or the

wife in one year's time.

The final vignette proves the most entertaining, as it focuses upon the raison d'être of the three previous women—their mother. Miss Rosen effectively portrays a crotchety old biddy who belittles the man she has borne three children by and mocks her daughters behind their backs.

In each of the scenes, Miss Rosen is more than ably assisted by Jerry Corwin and Tom Klasek, who alternate play her male counterpart.

## IRA on alert as violence grows

BELFAST (AP) — The Irish Republican Army's Provisional wing declared yesterday it has placed its guerrillas on alert after three days of violence left nearly a dozen persons dead and scores wounded.

The IRA statement, issued in Dublin, did not say it was ending the two-month truce arranged

with the British for Ulster, but it apparently gave local units greater independence.

An eruption of weekend shootings and bombings continued yesterday, with a bomb exploding in a car outside a bar in the Catholic Oldpark section of Belfast, wounding three people.
