

# Tragedy-touched singer returns in form

Reba McEntire got the tears over with early.

They overflowed as she opened her comeback-from-tragedy tour Thursday at the Coliseum with a bravado performance of "Love Will Find Its Way."

It was her first concert appearance since most of the members of her band were killed in a plane crash March 16.

Wearing a dramatic green-and-black sequined tuxedo-like top over black pants, McEntire was greeted by tumultuous applause. For a while, she couldn't get beyond the first song.

A crowd of about 12,000 hailed her appearance with a standing ovation and sustained applause that refused to die.

"I love y'all," McEntire said, the tears beginning to rain.

"We're back. Thank you."

She picked up a rose a fan had left on the stage. "I love y'all. Thank you."

Finally, she nodded to her new band, and they were off with the rest of a 21-song set that included one stunning encore.

McEntire had told People magazine she might never again sing her classic show closer, "Sweet Dreams." It probably was the last song she did with her band before the fateful final journey of the six performers and her road manager.

But Thursday night, McEntire sent her voice back up to the rafters for the old Patsy Cline sobber. She did the solo a cappella, as she normally does. But this time, there was no band on stage to turn around to afterwards. She entered for the encore alone, stage left.

Waves of applause and cheers interrupted her many times as she struggled to complete the encore.

"Oh, y'all, this is hard," McEntire said at one point, her eyes moistening again.

"Thank you very much. I love you. Sweet dreams."

It was clearly one of the toughest nights of her life. Yet her performance underscored the tough underbelly of her persona and her music.

Some of her lyrics seemed especially poignant.

"Walk On," sang McEntire, striding across the stage, to show she meant it. "You know you've got to stand tall," she sang from her hit version of the Everly Brothers' "Cathy's Clown."

There was a furrow to her brow, a sadness to the eyes that normally isn't there.

But McEntire — and her eight-member band — did beautifully. Six new musicians joined sax player Joe McGlohon and steel guitarist Pete Finney, who took an earlier plane March 16. McEntire had stayed behind in San Diego to catch up on sleep.

The show here was incredibly polished, given the short preparation time. Special kudos to backup singer Trish Arthur, who made beautiful harmonies with McEntire on "How Blue" and "New Fool at an Old Game."

The full band shone on McEntire's wonderful duet with opening act Vince Gill, "Oklahoma Swing."

Especially good were Glen Duncan on fiddle, Howard Duck on keys, guitarist Andre Reiss and Bob Mummert, the drummer.

McGlohon provided a wonderful moment with his sax solo from the bleachers, giving McEntire a chance

to execute a fast costume change into a dramatic, full-length blue gown before her great soul tune, "Sunday Kind of Love."

She showed a lot of soul, and a lot of guts.

Clint Black, the other headliner, was, as usual, superb. The guy can sing the blues — and sizzle them, too, on harp and guitar. He opened with Waylon Jennings' "Way More's Blues" and closed with his favorite, stomping encore, "Steamroller Blues." But he and his wonderful six-member band moved with equal aplomb through Texas-style honky-tonk and swing. Guitarist Hayden Nicholas, collaborator on such hits as "Killin' Time" and "Better Man," was hot.

The charismatic Black, with his classic Roy Rogers-style cowboy squint, has two great albums under his belt and is working on music for another. His producer, James Stroud, was at the performance and said Black recently recorded a duet with none other than Roy Rogers. Can't think of a better pairing.

Gill, meanwhile, is not bad with his own talented, seven-member band. His seven-song set included his biggest hit, the lovely country waltz "When I Call Your Name," and current Top 20 favorite, "Pocket Full of Gold."
