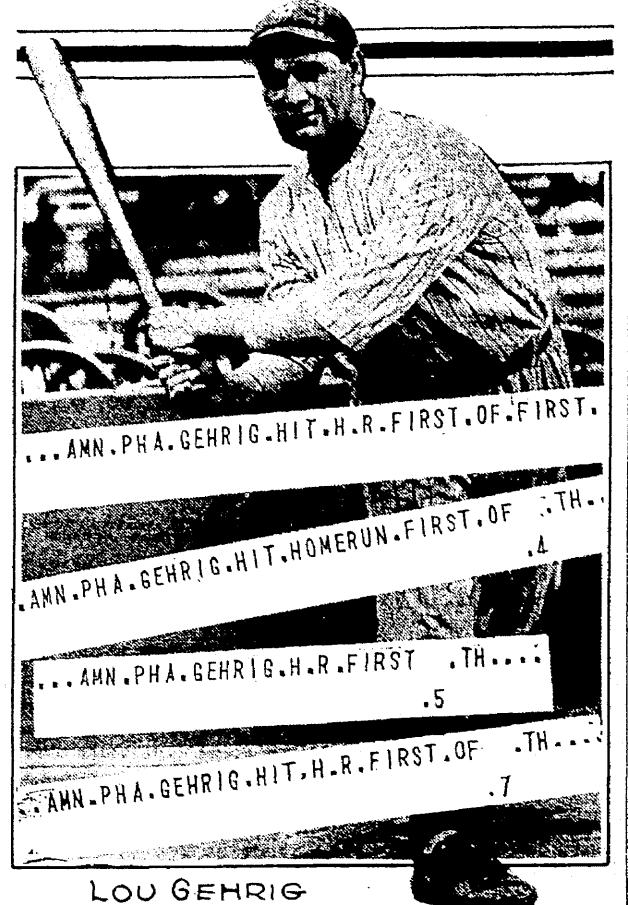
INDIANS WIN TWO; GEHRIG SMASHES FOUR HOMERS
